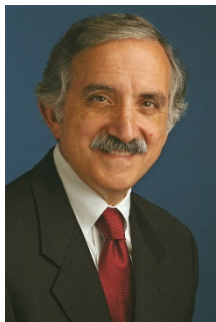
Connecting with the North Carolina Defense Industry
